Tiemonium Methylsulphate
50 mg Tablet & 100 ml Syrup

Visnil (Tiemonium Methylsulphate) is an antispasmodic drug that reduces muscles spasm of the intestine, biliary system, bladder and uterus.

COMPOSITION

Visnil Tablet: Each film coated tablet contains Tiemonium Methylsulphate INN 50 mg.

Visnil Syrup: Each 5ml syrup contains Tiemonium Methylsulphate INN 10 mg.

INDICATION

Visnil (Tiemonium Methylsulphate) is used in symptomatic treatment of pain related to functional disorders of the digestive tract and biliary system. It is also indicated for the treatment of spasm and pain in urological and gynaecological diseases.

DOSAGE AND ADMINISTRATION

Adult: usual dose is 2-6 tablets or 3-9 teaspoonfuls syrup daily in divided doses.

Children: 3 ml/kg or 6 mg/kg body weight daily in divided doses.

SIDE EFFECT

Tiemonium Methylsulphate may have the risk of hypotension & tachycardia in certain individuals.

PRECAUTION

Caution should be taken during treatment of patients with disorders of the prostate. Caution should also be taken in case of chronic bronchitis, coronary insufficiency, ambient hyperthermia, renal & hepatic insufficiency. The risks of visual disturbances can make it dangerous to drive or use machines.

CONTRAINDICATION

It should not be used in urethroprostatic disorder involving a risk of urine retention. It is contraindicated in patient with having risk of angle closure glaucoma.

USE IN PREGNANCY AND LACTATION

The results of animal studies of Tiemonium Methylsulphate did not reveal any teratogenic effects; no deformities have been reported up till now with normal use. In absence of sufficient data, prudence should be the rule for nursing mothers although no problems have been reported with normal use.

STORAGE

Keep in dry place and away from light and heat. Keep out of the reach of children.

Visnil Tablet: Each box contains 50 tablets in Alu-PVC blister pack.

Visnil Syrup: Each Amber PET bottle contains 100 ml syrup.
