

Composition

Each sustained release capsule contains Mebeverine Hydrochloride BP 200 mg.

Pharmacology

Mevigut SR is a musculotropic antispasmodic agent used to relieve cramps or spasms of the stomach and intestine (gut). It is particularly useful in treating irritable bowel syndrome (IBS) and similar conditions. It works by relaxing the muscles and helping to restore the normal movement of the gut.

Indicatons

- For the symptomatic treatment of irritable bowel syndrome (IBS)
- Other conditions include:
 - 1 Chronic irritable colon
 - 2. Spastic constipation
 - Mucus colitis
 - 4. Colicky abdominal pain and cramps
 - 5. Persistent non-specific diarrhea

Dosage and administration

Adults & Children over 10 years: One Mevigut SR capsule twice daily. Swallow the capsule with at least 100 ml of water, do not chew.

Contraindications

Hypersensitivity to Mebeverine or any components of the product.

Side Effects

Few side effects like skin rash, urticaria and angioedema may appear.

Warning & Precautions

Mebeverine Hydrochloride should be used with caution in patient with liver or kidney problems.

Use in Pregnancy & Lactation

No teratogenicity has been shown in animal experiments. However, the usual precautions concerning the administration of any drug during pregnancy should be exercised.

There is insufficient information of the excretion of Mebeverine in human breast milk. Therefore it should not take during breast-feeding.

Use in children & adolescent

Mebeverine capsule is not recommended for use in children aged less than 10 years.

Drug Interaction

No interaction studies have been performed.

Overdose

On theoretical grounds, it may be predicted that CNS excitability might occur in case of overdosage. No specific antidote is known; gastric lavage and symptomatic treatment is recommended.

Storage condition

Keep below 30°C temperature, protected from light & moisture. Keep out of the reach of children.

Packing

Each box contains 30 capsules in Alu-PVDC blister pack.
