

COMPOSITION

Each film coated tablet contains Zinc Orotate Dihydrate INN equivalent to Zinc Orotate 60 mg.

PHARMACOLOGY

Zinc is an essential co-factor for enzymes, which control many cell processes including DNA synthesis, normal growth, brain development, behavioral response, reproduction, bone formation, and wound healing. Zinc can inhibit rhinovirus replication and has activity against other respiratory viruses such as respiratory syncytial virus.

INDICATIONS

Oral Zinc therapy is indicated in Zinc deficiency or conditions like weak immune function, delayed wound healing, diarrhea, common cold, age-related macular degeneration etc.

DOSAGE & ADMINISTRATION

One tablet twice daily with meal or as per physician recommended.

CONTRAINDICATION

It is contraindicated in patients with hypersensitivity to the active substance or to any of the excipients of the tablet.

WARNING AND PRECAUTIONS

Accumulation of Zinc may occur in cases of renal failure patients.

SIDE-EFFECTS

Zinc might cause nausea, bad taste etc.

DRUG INTERACTIONS

Concomitant intake of Tetracycline, Quinolone and Penicillamine along with Zinc may decrease the absorption of both drugs. Clinicians should monitor Zinc status in patients taking Diuretics.

USE IN PREGNANCY & LACTATION

It should be used in pregnant or lactating mother after consultation with a health care professional.

USE IN CHILDREN & ADOLESCENTS

Consultation with health care professional is needed before giving this dietary supplement to children.

OVERDOSE

Higher Zinc intake might cause nausea, vomiting, loss of appetite, abdominal cramps, diarrhea and headaches.

STORAGE CONDITION

Keep below 30°C temperature, protected from light and moisture. Keep out of the reach of children.
